


HELP THE FIGHT

- Blood transfusions are a key treatment often used to relieve symptoms of sickle cell, an inherited blood disorder affecting approximately 100,000 people across the country and occurring in 1 out of every 365 African-American births.
- Patients are often in a chronic state of anemia and require frequent blood transfusions more closely matched to their own over time. After many transfusions, the best match for a sickle cell patient is often blood from an African-American donor. This reality is one of many reasons why we need a diverse and available blood supply.
